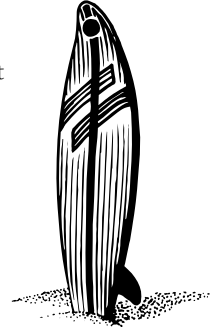
## Spring Pictures
